Do I need to complete Food Safety Supervisor Training?

Under the Food Act 2006, every licensable food business in Queensland is required to have a Qualified Food Safety Supervisor by 22nd February 2008.

Who should complete Food Safety Supervisor Training?

Anyone, including the business owner or employees can be a Food Safety Supervisor. The National Baking Industry Association (NBIA) recommends that at least one business owner and one supervising employee (i.e. Shop Supervisor) complete the training to ensure availability at all times under the legislation.

What are the requirements of the Food Safety Supervisor once training has been completed?

Nominated Food Safety Supervisors are required under legislation to take a lead role in supervising food safety within the business. Apart from completing the required training, they must also:-

- Have the ability to supervise food handling practices in the food business;
- Be reasonably available at all times the food business is operating; and
- Have the authority to supervise and give instructions to food handlers.

What does the Food Safety Supervisor course cover?

The course covers the skills and knowledge required to maintain personal hygiene and conduct, food handling, housekeeping and waste disposal related to work tasks and responsibilities where work involves operation of production and/or packaging equipment and processes. Topics include Implementing food safety programs, Maintaining and improving food safety and Complying with personal hygiene standards.

How is the Food Safety Supervisor Training delivered?

The course is delivered via workbook correspondence to enable self-paced learning. All students are provided with course materials and are required to complete workbook activities and assessments with additional telephone and email support available. The expected timeframe for completion is twelve (12) weeks.
